

# The Viking For Life Contest Rules and Regulations

## Eligibility

This contest is open to all students currently enrolled at Tennessee High School. All entries must have a name attached to it.

## Contest Period

The contest will run from September 24, 2018 to October 5, 2018. All entries must be submitted to Mr. Snyder, room 3421, by 2:30pm on Friday October, 2018. They may be submitted electronically or on paper. If submitting electronically, please email them to [snydera@btcs.org](mailto:snydera@btcs.org) with the subject line as "Viking For Life Logo".

## Contest Rules

The Viking for Life contest is a competition for Tennessee High School students who wish to make a lasting impact on the culture and school environment for years to come. Viking for Life is a new movement to promote Viking Pride throughout the Bristol and Northeast Tennessee communities. Thus, the contest rules are rather simple regarding what the logo must include and encompass. These are:

1. The Logo should be in color.
2. The Logo needs to incorporate some aspect of THS in order for people to notice the brand it is attached too (think outline of the Stone Castle or outline of the front entrance).
  - a. Note that those DO NOT need to be in the logo, it is merely an example of what we mean by "aspect of THS"
3. The Logo needs to incorporate the phrase "Viking for Life" in some fashion.
4. The Logo should be kept to a maximum measurement of 8.5 X 11 inches (roughly the size of a piece of blank copy paper).

## Winnings

The overall winner will be chosen by a group of carefully selected judges. The winner will receive:

1. \$100.00 Cash
2. Their name engraved on the new Field House currently under construction in the Stone Castle
3. The ability of seeing their logo on cars, windows, doors, and other locations in and around Tennessee High School, the Bristol Community, and throughout Northeast Tennessee.

## Judging

Judging will take place sometime after October 5, 2018. All judges have been carefully selected and will be consisted of THS teachers, administrators, and community members.
